

Transmission Based Precautions

Upon admission, residents are placed on prophylactic Transmission Based Precautions. Why?

- Precautions are implemented to ensure resident and staff safety. In addition to standard precautions, this will help prevent the spread of infection.

How long will the resident remain on prophylactic Transmission Based Precautions?

- If the resident does not have an active infection, precaution will end 14 days from date of admission. If there is an active infection, that date will be determined by physician.

Are visits permitted while my family member is on prophylactic Transmission Based Precautions?

- Residents may have one visitor at a time and all appropriate personal protective equipment must be worn
